#### Centre Guidelines for Participants

The Centre guidelines are there in an effort to ensure the safety, wellbeing and privacy of all those who attend Centre courses. They are complementary to the visiting group's established guidelines for educational visits and will be explained in more detail to participants on their arrival. A résumé of the guidelines which we expect participants to adhere to during their time at the Centre are listed below:-

#### General

Participants:-

Should behave in a sensible manner around the Centre at all times

Must follow Centre staff's instructions/directions during activities

Must remain within the Centre grounds unless given specific permission to do otherwise

Should adhere to the agreed lights out/bedtime

Should refrain from opening external doors or venturing outside after the agreed lockup time

Should respect others belongings and privacy

Will be required to assist with maintaining the Centre's cleanliness ie. keeping common areas

& dormitories clean & tidy, assisting with some basic Centre chores

Must not use Centre apparatus which requires specialist supervision/instruction

#### Fire

Smoking is not permitted anywhere inside the Centre, those who are of the legal age to smoke must do so in the designated area

Participants must not interfere with fire safety equipment ie. Fire alarm/detectors or Fire extinguishers

Participants will be made familiar with fire exits, alarm siren, fire assembly point and the action to be taken in the event of the alarm activating

Assist with fire prevention by not wedging fire doors, including dormitory doors open at any time

### Mobile Phones

All participants are requested to leave Mobile Phones at home. Resident visitors can be contacted through the Office at the Centre. Where participants insist on bringing Mobile Phones the following will apply.

Participants will be requested to hand over their Phones to their teachers/leaders to be kept securely and issued at agreed prescribed times

Participants will not be allow to take Phones on outdoor activities unless given specific permission to do so by Centre staff
