Where to arrive?

We are based at St Columba's Church of Ireland in Kilcooley. This is on the Drumhirk Road, which is the main road through Kilcooley from the Ring Road and Rathgael Road.

When to arrive?

Morning session begins at 10am

When to get collected?

4pm from St Columba's.

What to Wear?

Warm and old clothes. Bring plenty of layers. Some of the activities will involve painting and other odd jobs. Some people bring clothes, hats and scarves too.

What will we be doing?

After morning devotions, there will be a wide range of activities from Holiday Bible Club to a wall mural to flyer drops to painting fences. You'll be a team of 8-12 people during the event, with leaders assigned to each team
