Safety Shoes Required.

The **"Azamara Pursuit**" is a Cruise ship that is in Belfast for a major interior refit. Before their arrival I contacted them to see if I could be of help to them during their time here. One of the things they needed was safety shoes for seven crew members whose safety equipment hadn't arrived at the port. I was able to supply them with suitable safety shoes for the men.

They also required warm clothing and wooly hats.

One of the crew members has been hospitalized and I have been able to visit him a number of times as well.

The ship's company wanted to help out in some way and they had some food supplies over that they couldn't use so instead of dumping these supplies they sought permission to give them to a local "FoodBank"
