



Statement of faith:

 Following Him in seeking social outcasts (vv.9-10)

Following Him in rebuking sinful attitudes (vv.11-13)

"When the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and 'sinners'?"
On hearing this, Jesus said, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.' For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners."



 Following Him in proclaiming the good news (v.35)

"Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness."



 Following Him in proclaiming the good news (v.35) continued.

The gospel message:


1 Corinthians 15:1-4"Now, brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.
